**Grades K-2: Habitat Explorers:** Experience life in the wetlands by learning about what lives there and how they survive.

**Grade 3: Wetland Transformers:** Students study the special adaptations that wetland plants and animals depend upon for survival.

**Grade 4: What Comes Around Goes Around:** Students place themselves in the wetlands food web and discover how it's all connected

**Grade 5: Where's the Water?** Students solve the mystery Where's the Water? Involves community investigation, water cycle, and weather study.

**Middle School: What's Under There?** Dig in! to wetlands soil, discover how erosion by water shapes the Lake Tahoe landscape.

**High School:** Watershed and Wetlands Field Studies: explore the fields of Ecology, Biology and Chemistry through UC Davis research. Students explore current watershed issues such as global warming, human activity, and the introduction of non-native species.
