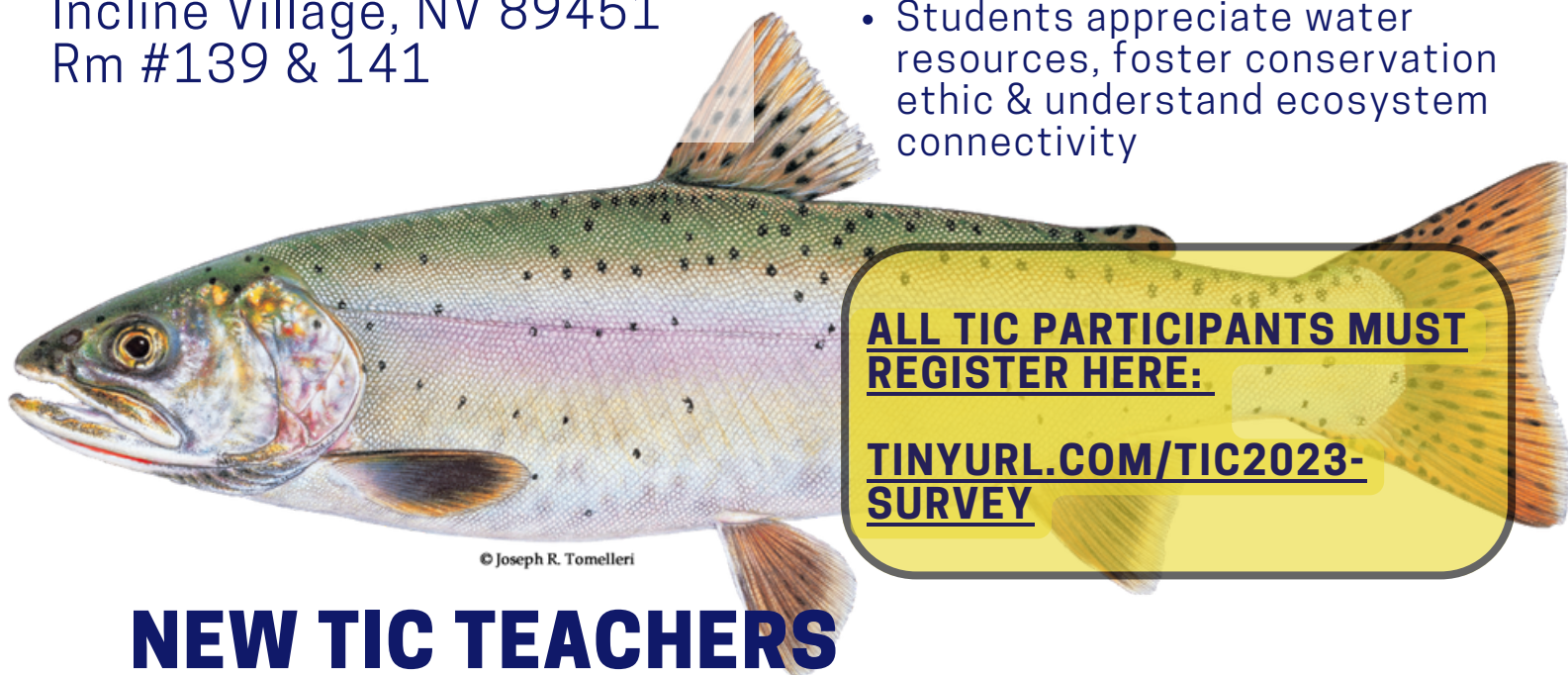

Topics covered include: how to care for trout eggs, tank set-up, equipment\* & procedures, biology and ecology of Lahonton Cutthroat Trout, and introduction to teaching resources.
